Sub: School Education Department – Rules relating to admission of students into Elementary Teacher Training Institutes / District Institutes of Education and Training through Common Entrance Test Rules, 2015 – Reducing qualifying marks in the DEECET-2017 only and for making admissions with or without DEECET for the years 2016-17 and 2017-18 only – Orders issued.

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In the circumstances reported by the Commissioner of School Education, A.P. Amaravati in the reference 3<sup>rd</sup> cited, after careful examination of the matter, permission is hereby accorded to the Commissioner of School Education, A.P. Amaravati, and Chairperson, DEECET (Diploma in Elementary Education Common Entrance Test) to reduce the qualifying marks in the DEECET-2017 in relaxation of Rule 4 (ii) DEECET- Rules, 2015 issued in G.O. Ms.No.30 School Education (Prog.II) Dept. dated: 08.07.2015 for the DEECET-2017 only, as follows:

For OCs	50% marks	35% marks
For BCs	50% marks	35% marks
For PH	45% marks	No minimum qualifying marks
For SCs	45% marks	No minimum qualifying marks
For STs	45% marks	No minimum qualifying marks

2. Further, keeping in view of the future of the students, on humanitarian grounds, Government hereby accord permission to allow the spot /institutional admissions viz...Convener leftover seats of Category A and Management leftover seats of Category "B" filled up by the Managements of Pvt. D.Ed Colleges with or without DEECET for the academic year 2016-17 and furnish the list of students admitted in Private D.Ed. College wise, duly verifying the original records by the Director of Government Examinations, A.P. Hyderabad.

3. Further, Permission is accorded to allow the Managements of Pvt. D.Ed Colleges to fill up Convener leftover seats of Category A and Management leftover seats of Category "B" by them with or without DEECET-2017 for the academic year 2017-2018 only in relaxation of Rules 6 (IV) (A) (xiii) and 6 (B) (I) (xii) . However, the Managements of Private D.Ed Colleges should obtain permission individually from the Government within 90 days for filling up of such leftover seats from the date of completion of admission process as fixed by the Convener DEECET.

4. Further, permission is accorded to the Commissioner of School Education and Chairperson DEECET to give options to the Managements who are willing to conduct English as medium of instruction for conducting English Medium D.El.Ed. Course and accordingly she is requested to prepare modalities like preparation of separate English medium Govt Text Books, preparation of question papers and valuation etc for change of medium of D.El.Ed course from Telugu to English.
